

#### **Earthquake Waves**

When earthquakes happen, the grounds shake. Waves move out from the center of an earthquake.

There are two kinds of earthquake waves. The first is called an S-wave. An S-wave looks like the letter S turned on its side. It moves along the surface like a ripple on a pond. Sometimes we say the "S" in "S-wave" stands for "surface".

Strong S-waves do a lot of damage. They **wreck** buildings and even whole cities. This is because the S-waves lift up buildings and then drop them. The buildings fall apart.

The other kind of earthquake is called a P-wave. The "P" here stands for pressure". P-waves do not move along the surface. Instead, they travel deep through the Earth. P-waves tell us much about the inside of the Earth. By **tracking** them, we find out what is deep underground. P-waves give us a picture of our planet's inside. So, in a way, the "P" stands for "picture" too.
